CHILDREN’S CHANGE JARS: Bless and thank you again for contributing your coin jars in July. Your act of compassion has several benefits for children that you might not realize. 1) You help advance their education. Malnourished children have deficits in brain development that make it harder for them to learn. Getting enough to eat helps children succeed in their studies, which is their best hope for escaping from the cycle of poverty. 2) You help them survive disease. Even mild malnutrition makes children twice as likely to die from respiratory diseases, malaria, or diarrhea. By feeding children, you give them the strength to survive spreading infections. 3) You help them grow (all the way) up. Stunted growth is the most obvious sign that children are not getting enough.
