At this service to dedicate our beautiful Rodgers organ, we will be blessed with a special sacred concert presented by internationally renowned organist Dan Miller. In fact, he is coming here directly from an international organ concert and classes in China on his way back home!

He comes with a vast background of music, having served as a church organist since the age of fifteen and has served at numerous churches around the country through the years. Currently he is the organist for St. Matthew Lutheran Church and a guest organist for Bethel Congregational Church, both in Beaverton, Oregon, and as guest organist for Rose City Park United Methodist Church in Portland, as well as a guest organist at many other churches nationwide.

Mr. Miller holds a Church Music Diploma from Moody Bible Institute. He majored in organ performance at the American Conservatory of Music, holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Florida Atlantic University and a Master of Music degree in Organ Performance from Winthrop University. Additionally, he has numerous organ CD recordings. He is in his 18th year at Rodgers Instruments US LLC, one of the world's leading organ builders, in Hillsboro, Oregon, as Rodgers Artist and Tonal Professional. He also is an Adjunct Professor of Organ at George Fox University in Newberg, Oregon.
