Coming This Fall to Ukiah

AMEN (Adventist Medical Evangelism Network), a non-profit network of physicians and dentists is dedicated to providing free dental and medical care to those who are uninsured or under-insured.

This free clinic is made possible by volunteers and by donations and will be coming to Ukiah October 17-20, 2017. The actual clinic service dates are the 18th-20th, but the 17th is set-up day at which time a minimum of 20-30 volunteers are needed for this one day to prepare for the clinic. (Take-down will be Friday afternoon.) Set-up day will be for doing many different preparations, for example setting up tables and curtain dividers, computer set-ups, etc. This clinic will be held at the Ukiah Fairgrounds.

Many volunteers are necessary for the daily operation of this endeavor, in both the dental area and the medical. Professionals in all medical and dental fields are needed, as well as support people for hospitality, crowd control, to help in waiting areas and registration, etc. Additionally, cooks will be needed to prepare lunch and dinner for the volunteers. How Hot Do Cars Get?

Have you ever noticed how hot it can get inside a car on a summer day--far hotter than it is outside? That is because a car acts like a greenhouse, trapping the sun's heat. You can go to mydogiscool.com and check out the animated video of the greenhouse effect in action on a hot car. A study from Stanford University shows that even on comparatively cool days, such as 72°, a car's internal temperature will rocket to 116 degrees within 60 minutes. And keeping the windows open a crack hardly slows the rise at all.
