AMEN Health Clinic

This month the AMEN Medical and Dental Clinic will be happening right here in Ukiah. AMEN (Adventist Medical Evangelism Network) is a non-profit network of physicians and dentists dedicated to providing these services to those who are uninsured or under-insured.

During these few days we expect to see lives changed as we witness a giving and caring spirit of unity with the purpose of helping and serving others, doing a work that we are committed to because of the love and grace that God has given to us and then placed in our hearts the desire to share this love with each individual we will be serving.

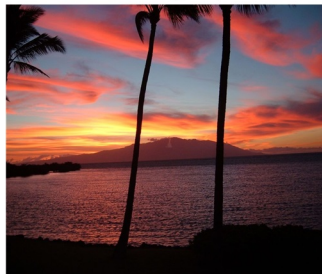
