YOUTH/CHILDREN'S SABBATH SCHOOL: We are glad to announce that Youth and Children's Sabbath School met last week for the first time since March! County Health officials have given the green light for stable groups of kids no larger than 14 students to meet for religious education. We want to encourage all of our children to come to Sabbath School. Even though these classes are now functioning, we need to understand that this is not a full opening. There is a limit of 2 adult teachers per classroom, a max of 14 students, and the group must be a stable cohort of kids. The latter specifically and unfortunately means that we need to not encourage 1 time visitors from attending our Lower Division classes. As the months roll by we expect the county to further open up the rules. Thank you for your patience and understanding in this area.

CHILDREN'S CHANGE JARS: Bless and thank you again for contributing to this worthy cause. Your act of compassion has several benefits for children that you might not realize, 1) You help advance their education. Malnourished children have deficits in brain development that make it harder for them to learn. Getting enough to eat helps children succeed in their studies, which is their best hope for escaping from the cycle of poverty. 2) You help them survive disease. Even mild malnutrition makes children twice as likely to die from respiratory diseases, malaria, or diarrhea. By feeding children, you give them the strength to survive spreading infections. 3) You help them grow (all the way) up. Stunted growth is the most obvious sign that children are not getting enough. Jars will be collected on December 19 and once again on January 2, 2021.
